

Guidelines for

Kitesports at Newgale

Kitesurfing Codes of Conduct

- Riders must hold 3rd party Insurance.
- Be sure you can handle the prevailing weather conditions.
- Always assist fellow kitesurfers when launching and landing.
- Always use an effective kite safety leashing system.
- Wrap your lines when not in use and secure kite properly.
- Keep a reasonable distance between you and your fellow kitesurfers / beach users.
- A kitesurfer must know the navigation laws and abide by them at all times
- If you ride alone, let someone know you are out and what time you will be expected back.
- If you lose your kite or board whilst on the water, always report it to the coastguard.
- When learning seek professional tuition.

Land Kiting Codes of Conduct

- Riders and flyers must hold 3rd party insurance
- Set up and keep clear of congested areas of the beach
- Be aware of other beach users and do not fly kites or pass too close.
- Do not fly when overpowered and out of control
- Always use an effective kite safety leashing system
- Wrap your lines when not in use and secure kite properly
- Do not use kites or wheels unless there is enough space, allow for at least 3 hours after high tide
- Use appropriate safety equipment. (Helmets and Pads)

Specific Location Risks

- No power kite flying or use of wheels in shaded area during lifeguard operating times
- No launching or landing from shingle bank.
- No kitesurfing 2 hrs either side of high tide.
- No land kiting 3 hrs either side of high tide
- Give way to all other watercraft and water users

General Information

- Please keep clear of landing and launching kites
- Beware Kite Lines – do not touch
- Always stand upwind of kite flyers who are on land
- Licensed schools only
