HOW CAN OUTDOOR RECREATION PROVIDERS CAN GET INVOLVED?

If a provider wants to get involved that would be amazing!

They would be acting as a Host storing the equipment and providing it to the public. As long as they are offering the equipment for free then we cover the insurance and maintenance etc. Our booking system has simplified the process, so it is a matter of checking in and out and letting me know if any issues with the equipment. We have a very simple clear paper trail for this. We would then be advertising the service on our website, social media and coast to coast magazine with links to the provider. We are reviewing our Host offer to provide further incentives however all the feedback from hosts is extremely positive in relation to supporting the people hiring equipment. I would come and meet with them and review the local area and see what equipment works and depending on the outcome we can turn things around quite quick.

We have also started looking for business sponsors who are unable to host equipment but would like to sponsor a piece of equipment or certain area etc.

Moving forward we are looking for Hosts that can store batteries as there is a real need for electric chairs.

WHAT EQUIPMENT IS AVAILABLE?

We have increased the range available to hire as people's needs differ. This now includes all terrain rollators, beach wheelchairs in a variety of styles suitable for children and adults. And extreme wheelchairs designed for mud runners etc alongside our mountain trike chairs that are similar to mountain bikes.

We have Mobi matting, hoist and Gazebo for events and with enough notice can be quite flexible, more so out of season. I have included a couple of images.

IS THERE TRAINING TO USE THE EQUIPMENT SAFELY?

Most equipment is reliant of the client knowing their own needs the equipment itself is simple but doesn't meet everyone's individual needs and we encourage people to try different chairs at different venues. We are making some "how too" videos etc this year and trying to recruit volunteers. Our more specialist equipment such as hoist we have provided training for. We do not expect Hosts to support in moving and handling if this is outside normal remit.
